

FT8 WESA RULES

Award Manager ZL1MVL

In recognition of international two-way FT8 amateur radio communication, the FT8 Digital Mode Club (FT8DMC) issues Worked-English-Stations-Award certificates to amateur radio stations and SWL of the world. Qualification for the FT8 WESA award is based on an examination by the FT8 WESA Award Manager. The applicant has to prove that he has made contact with at least 10 different amateur radio stations from England. All contacts must be made from the same country (DXCC entity).

Levels:

CLASS III: 10 Stations worked

CLASS II: 25 Stations worked

CLASS I: 50 Stations worked
